Dear Dr Tarkanyi,

The International Nuclear Data Committee (INDC) was established to advise the IAEA on its programmatic activities in the field of nuclear data for applications. A copy of its current Terms of Reference is attached for your information.


I believe that your knowledge and experience would prove valuable to the Committee, and, in this connection, I am pleased to ask you to serve as a member of INDC for a three-year period with effect from 1 January 2010.

The next meeting of the INDC is planned to take place at the IAEA's Headquarters in Vienna 25 – 28 May 2010. The Secretariat will send you a list of agenda items and the necessary background documents well in advance of the meeting. The meeting will be held in English only.

In view of the continuing budgetary constraints, Governments are asked to bear the travel and living expenses of the members of advisory groups from their country. If necessary, the IAEA would, wherever possible, cover the expenses of INDC members from developing countries to attend the regular meetings.

I would be grateful if you could confirm your agreement to participate in the work of the INDC at your earliest convenience.
